

National Parkinson Foundation Thanksgiving Greeting Card Contest

OFFICIAL RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The National Parkinson Foundation Thanksgiving Greeting Card Contest (“The Contest”) is open to individuals in all countries except where prohibited by law. Submissions will be accepted from individuals of all ages as of the start date of the Contest. Submissions from minors, under the age of 18 must be completed by an adult parent or guardian and noted in the comments section of the submission form.
2. **ORGANIZER:** The Contest is organized by The National Parkinson Foundation.
3. **AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES:** Participation in the Contest constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of the Organizer, which are final and binding. Winning the Contest is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. The Organizer reserves the right to terminate this Contest at any time.
4. **CONTEST PERIOD:** The contest begins Aug. 1, 2012. Entries will be accepted until midnight 12:00am on Sept. 14, 2012.
5. **SUBMISSION:** During the Submission Period, go to www.parkinson.org/thanksgiving (“the Website”) to submit a design for the Contest. You may enter as many submissions as you wish. However, participants will only be eligible to receive one (1) Prize in relation to the Contest.

Contest Submissions cannot be revised or altered once submitted. Incomplete or inaccurate entries are void. All Submissions are subject to the Foldees.com general Submission Terms and Conditions found at [insert website]. Moderation of all submissions will be performed by the Organizer according to these Submission Terms and Conditions.

By entering the contest, you agree to release and hold harmless the Organizer and its officers, directors, employees, and agents from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of your submission or your participation in any phase of this Contest.

Any Submissions received during the Submission Period may be used by the Organizer for promotional purposes including but not limited to inclusion in any printed and electronic media, without prior consent from entrants and without any further consideration in the form of any payment or royalties.

6. **JUDGING:** Three top entries will be chosen by the organizer and featured on the NPF Facebook page www.facebook.com/parkinsondotorg. One winner will be selected from amongst the top three by NPF Facebook fans by way of a rating system—the entry that receives the most “likes”

will be chosen as a the winner.

The Submissions that receive the highest ratings at the end of the Rating Period will receive prizes in ascending order i.e. the submission with the highest rating will receive the First Prize— showcase of their artwork on the NPF Thanksgiving card, spotlight on the artwork on NPF's Facebook page, an NPF prize package (NPF bag, wristband and pin). The second and third highest rating will receive a spotlight on the NPF Facebook page and an NPF prize package (NPF bag, wristband and pin).

In the event of a tie or any other dispute, the Organizer will decide the list of winners. Decisions of the Organizer are final. Winning submissions will be announced on the Website and on the NPF Facebook page after the rating period has ended.

7. **REQUIREMENTS OF THE POTENTIAL WINNER:** Potential Winners will be notified if their submission is selected as one of the winning submissions. Potential winner is not a winner until he/she has returned all required documentation and eligibility has been verified by the Organizer. Potential Winner must comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. If a potential winner cannot be contacted within three (3) days after the first attempt to contact him/her, the submission with the next highest rating will be deemed the next winner.
8. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:** In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, or other technical problem, the Organizer may, in its sole discretion, either: (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Contest in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules; or (b) award prizes at random from among the eligible Submissions received up to the time of the impairment. The Organizer reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in a disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Organizer reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Organizer's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
9. **RELEASE AND LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY:** By participating in the Contest, entrants agree to release and hold harmless Organizer from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Contest or receipt or use of any prize, including, but not limited to: (a) unauthorized human intervention in the Contest; (b) technical errors related to computers, servers, providers, or telephone or network lines; (c) printing errors; (d) lost, late, postage-due, misdirected, or undeliverable mail; (e) errors in the administration of the Contest or the processing of Submissions; or (f) injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Contest or receipt or

use of any prize. Entrant waives the right to claim any damages whatsoever, including, but not limited to, punitive, consequential, direct, or indirect damages.

10. DISPUTES: Except where prohibited, entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Contest or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of legal action. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrant's rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Organizers in connection with the Contest, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the state of Florida in the United State of America.
