NEW YORK AND NEW JERSEY

In the last five years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$5,057,200** in research, better care, and education + empowerment for the **New York and New Jersey Parkinson's Disease (PD) Community**.



IMPROVING CARE

- Trained **2,310 health professionals**
- Offered help through **9,250 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **64,450 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Funded **four Centers of Excellence**.....

Treated **10,370** people at our Centers of Excellence

335 enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD



RESEARCH

- **28 researchers** and **1 research center** (Columbia University Irving Medical Center) received grants totaling **\$3,572,000**
- **15 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective and **10 ambassadors** were trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

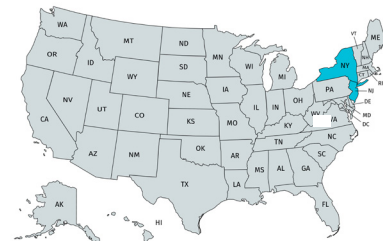


EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT

- **3,620 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **4,990 people** participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed on-line
- **3,400 people** received free services through 12 community grants totaling **\$184,000**
- **6,060 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,556,500** through Moving Day
