## Florida Chapter Impact Report for 2022



In the last 5 years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested \$6,902,361 in research, better care, and education & empowerment for the FLORIDA Parkinson's Disease (PD) Community

#### IMPROVING CARE



- Trained 1,091 health professionals
- Offered help through 8,473 calls to our Helpline
- Distributed 106,339 free publications in English and Spanish
- Raised \$1,121,994 in funding for our Centers of Excellence

#### RESEARCH



- 11 researchers received grants totaling \$2,504,331
- 41 research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective and 5 ambassadors trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

### **EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT**

• 12,321 Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital



- 7,117 people participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed online
- 23,523 people received free services through 61 community grants totallying \$772,796
- 11,525 people walked for Parkinson's and raised \$3,847,051 through Moving Day

#### TREATMENT AND PREVALENCE



- 63,373 people with PD live in the Florida Chapter and amass \$3.17B in expenses related to PD
- 3,745 participants enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD
- Treated 76,615 people at our Centers of Excellence
