In the last 5 years, the Parkinson's Foundation has invested **\$4,581,751** in research, better care, and education & empowerment for the **MARYLAND, VIRGINIA, WEST VIRGINIA, DELAWARE, DC, AND EASTERN PENNSYLVANIA** Parkinson's Disease (PD) Community

### IMPROVING CARE



- Trained **2,564 health professionals**
- Offered help through **6,581 calls** to our Helpline
- Distributed **53,274 free publications** in English and Spanish
- Raised **\$1,229,764 in funding** for our Centers of Excellence

### RESEARCH



- **24 researchers** received grants totaling **\$1,552,177**
- **87 research advocates** paired with scientists to make research more effective and **7 ambassadors** trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

### EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT



- **4,255 Aware in Care kits** prepared people for the hospital
- **4,972 people** participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed online
- **13,344 people** received free services through **20 community grants** totalling **\$250,197**
- **2,608 people** walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$762,174** through Moving Day

### TREATMENT AND PREVALENCE



- **75,771 people** with PD live in the Mid-Atlantic Chapter and amass **\$3.79B** in expenses related to PD
- **3,194 participants** enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD
- Treated **82,950 people** at our Centers of Excellence
