NEW ENGLAND

IMPROVING CARE



- Trained **1,403** health professionals
- Offered help through **3,092** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **22,290** free publications in English and Spanish
- Raised **\$611,945** in funding for our Centers of Excellence

RESEARCH



- **14** researchers received grants totaling **\$2,874,500**
- **33** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective and **6** ambassadors trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT



- **1,724** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **1,672** people participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed online
- **11,041** people received free services through **26** community grants totaling **\$410,922**
- **3,218** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$660,177** through Moving Day

TREATMENT AND PREVALENCE



- **37,437** people with PD live in the New England Chapter and amass **\$1.87B** in expenses related to PD
- **1,021** participants enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD
- Treated **23,191** people at our Centers of Excellence
