NEW YORK AND NEW JERSEY

IMPROVING CARE



- Trained **2,304** health professionals
- Offered help through **9,906** calls to our Helpline
- Distributed **61,172** free publications in English and Spanish
- Raised **\$1,259,804** in funding for our Centers of Excellence

RESEARCH



- **32** researchers received grants totaling **\$4,896,871**
- **104** research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective and **11** ambassadors trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT



- **3,437** Aware in Care kits prepared people for the hospital
- **8,442** people participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed online
- **9,381** people received free services through **36** community grants totaling **\$576,556**
- **5,165** people walked for Parkinson's and raised **\$1,358,572** through Moving Day

TREATMENT AND PREVALENCE



- **68,548** people with PD live in the New York and New Jersey Chapter and amass **\$3.43B** in expenses related to PD
- **1,369** participants enrolled in the **Parkinson's Outcomes Project**, the largest clinical study of PD
- Treated **56,531** people at our Centers of Excellence
