#### IMPROVING CARE



- Trained 2,304 health professionals
- Offered help through 9,906 calls to our Helpline
- Distributed 61,172 free publications in English and Spanish
- Raised \$1,259,804 in funding for our Centers of Excellence

## RESEARCH



- 32 researchers received grants totaling \$4,896,871
- 104 research advocates paired with scientists to make research more effective and 11 ambassadors trained to help change policies around PD care in hospitals

### **EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT**





- 8,442 people participated in educational programs, and hundreds more viewed online
- 9,381 people received free services through 36 community grants totallying \$576,556
- 5,165 people walked for Parkinson's and raised \$1,358,572 through Moving Day

#### TREATMENT AND PREVALENCE



- 68,548 people with PD live in the New York and New Jersey Chapter and amass \$3.43B in expenses related to PD
- 1,369 participants enrolled in the Parkinson's Outcomes Project, the largest clinical study of PD
- Treated 56,531 people at our Centers of Excellence
